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ORDER:-

In the G.O. 10th read above, certain amendments have been issued to the Andhra Pradesh Agriculture Subordinate Service Rules 1997, in view of the creation of the post of Village Agriculture Assistants in the Village Secretariats.

- 2. In the references 11^{th} read above, the Joint Secretary, Andhra Pradesh Public Service Commission, has noticed certain variations in the original G.O. 10^{th} read above, to that of draft G.O. sent to them.
- 3. Accordingly, Government after careful examination of the matter, hereby issue the following amendments to the Andhra Pradesh Agriculture Subordinate Service Rules 1997:-

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, and all other powers hereunto enabling, the Governor of Andhra Pradesh hereby makes the following amendments to the Andhra Pradesh Agricultural Subordinate Service Rules, 1997 issued in G.O.Ms.No.167, Agriculture & Cooperation (Agri-IV) Department, dated 17th April, 1997 as subsequently amended from time to time:

AMENDMENTS

In the said Rules,-

- 1. In Rule 3, in the table under Class-A
 - (i) Against Category (2), for the existing entries in column (2), the following entries shall be substituted, namely,-

i. By Direct Recruitment				
ii. By promotion from Category- 2A, i.e., Village Agriculture Assistant (Grade-II)				
iii. By promotion from Category 3, i.e. AEO Grade- III.				

- 2. For rule 7, the following shall be substituted, namely,-
 - "Minimum Service:- No person shall be eligible for appointment by transfer or by promotion unless he is an approved probationer and has put in not less than two (2) years of service in the Category from which promotion or appointment by transfer is made".
- 3. In the Annexure to rule 5, in the table under Class A before Category (4), the following shall be inserted, namely,-

		Note: (1) the Vacancies notified shall be filled with the candidates who possess the above qualifications in the ratio of 4:1:5 respectively out of every 10 vacancies.
		(2) If the candidates with the said qualifications in the ratio prescribed are not available among the applicants, such vacancies may be filled with the applicants available with other qualifications in the rotation as per merit.

		(3) Separate Roster Registers shall be followed for the candidates of the above three different qualifications.
		(4) Four (4) out of every Ten (10) vacancies of AEO (Grade-II) shall be filled by Direct Recruitment. Remaining Six (6) vacancies shall be filled by Promotion from AEO (Grade-III)/ Village Agriculture Assistant (Grade-II).
	By promotion	(i)Promotions shall be effected between AEO (Grade-III) and Village Agriculture Assistant (Grade-II) in the Ratio of 30:70, (i.e. 30% to AEO Grade-III and 70% to VAA Grade-II). If there are no AEO Gr.III the vacancies meant for them shall be filled by Village Agriculture Assistants Gr.II.
		(ii) Must have completed Two (2) years of service in the cadre of AEO (Gr-III)/ Village Agriculture Assistant (Grade-II)
		(iii) Must pass the Agriculture Department Test (Paper Code 144).
		(iv)Must be a approved probationer
Category 2 A Village Agriculture Assistant (Gr-II)	By Direct Recruitment	No person shall be eligible for appointment to the post of Village Agriculture Assistant (Grade-II) unless he possesses the following qualifications: Four(4)years B.Sc. (Ag)/ Four (4) years B.Tech. in Agricultural Engineering from a recognized University in the State/ any other University accredited by the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR), Ministry of Agriculture & Farmer Welfare, Govt. of India, New Delhi. (or) Two (2) Years Diploma in Agriculture Polytechnic (or) Two (2) years Diploma in Agriculture Polytechnic (Seed Technology) (or) Two (2) years Diploma in Agriculture Polytechnic (Organic Farming) (or) Three (3) years Diploma in Agriculture Polytechnic (Engineering) recognized by the ANGRAU.
